Oil Painting - Materials List

Painting – oil or acrylics

- Titanium White
- Cadmium Yellow
- Lemon Yellow
- Cadmium Red
- Raw Umber
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Cerulean Blue

Painting Medium for oil paints

- □ Terpenoid odorless paint thinner
- □ Refined linseed oil or stand oil (faster drying)
- □ Two containers for medium and paint thinner (small glass jars with lids work well)

Brushes

□ You can have either Rounds, Filberts, or Brights. Have a #2, #4, #6, and #8.

Other Materials

□ Canvases/ painting surfaces--- Have at least one canvas ready and the size of your choice. You can think of anything no bigger than 18 by 24 inches. Keep in mind that you will be making copies so your canvas will have to be close to the ratio to the master work you choose.

Palette knife

□ Please purchase a metal palette knife. Please have it with an "S" curved design such as the image below. The size can be something comfortable for you.

Rags

□ (old cotton t-shirt) or paper towel

For those students using acrylic paints PAFA will provide:

- ✓ Two containers for water
- ✓ Spray Bottle (to spray your paints to keep them from drying out)
